Sister Verlinda Munro was born December 29, 1931 to her parents, Joseph and Dollie Leary in New Bern, NC., and was second of six children. She attended West Craven High School. After graduating at the age of 16, she moved to New York City with family. She had careers in business, retail showcase design, domestic engineering, and as a home health aide.

Verlinda began studying the Bible with Jehovah's Witnesses in the early 1970's. She was baptized in 1978 at the International Victory Convention at Yankee Stadium in New York City.
